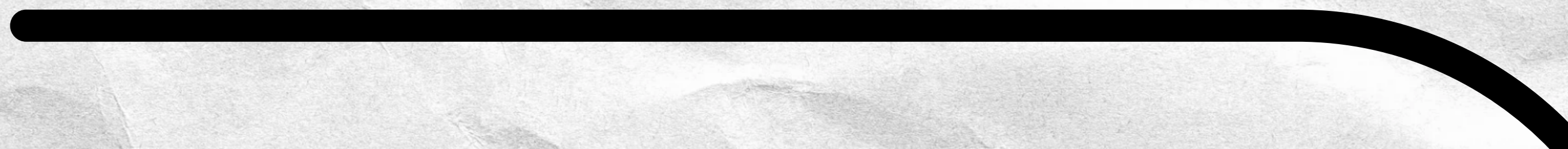

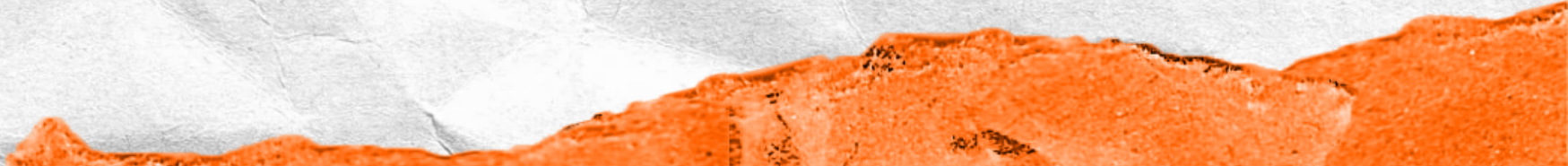

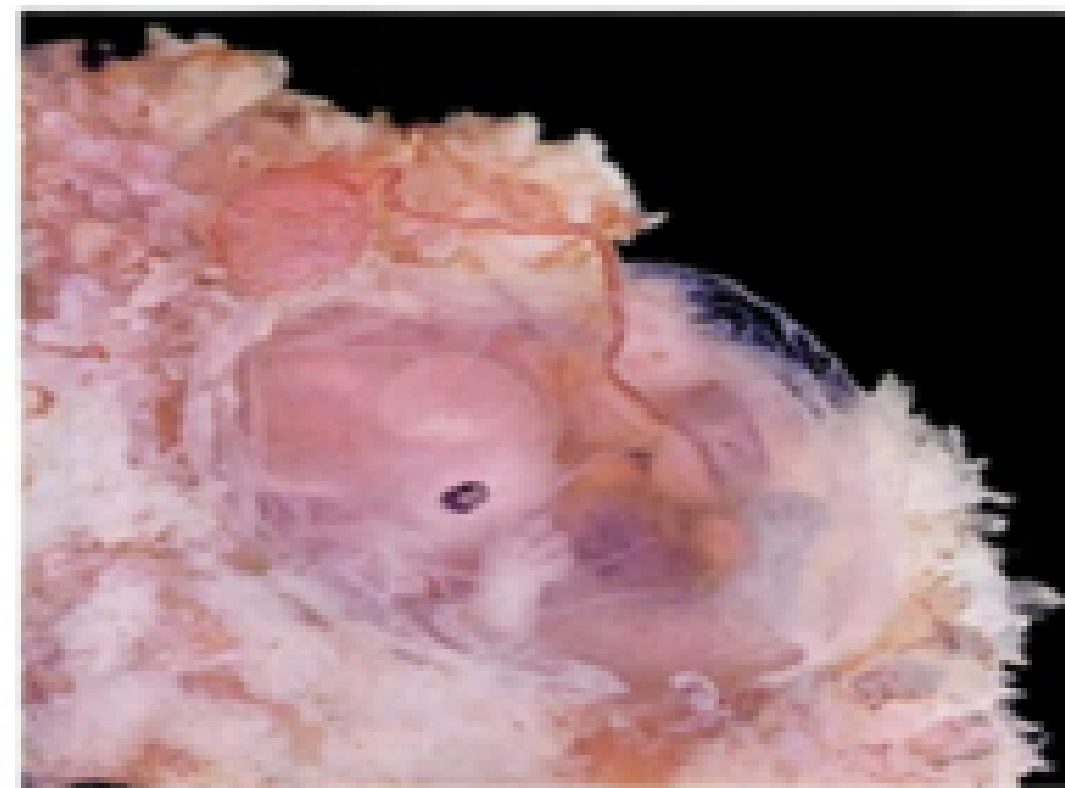

6 WEEKS

The Change—Embryo to Fetus



6 1/2 WEEKS

By the end of the sixth week, the embryo is about the size of a pea. The head is the most prominent feature, and the heart is visible as a small, dark spot. The limbs are beginning to form, and the body is curved in a C-shape.

8 WEEKS

At eight weeks, the embryo is about the size of a grape. The head is larger, and the heart is more prominent. The limbs are more developed, and the body is more elongated.

Growing Bones and Cramped Quarters

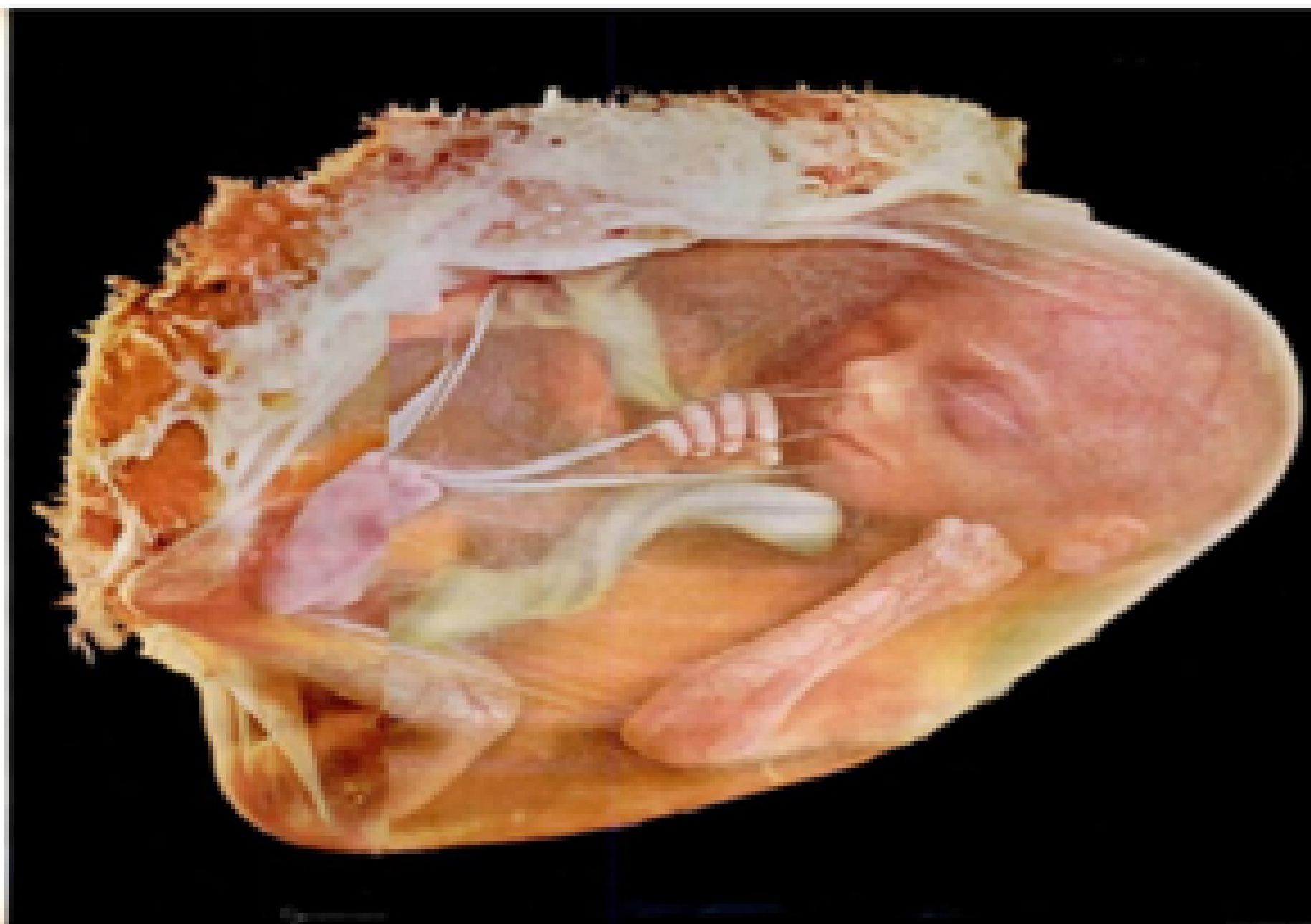


12 WEEKS

By the end of the 12th week, the fetus is about 10 centimeters long and weighs about 20 grams. The skull is made of cartilage, and the bones are beginning to form.
